

The submitted thesis compares the portrayals of several female characters in selected American novels dealing with the Holocaust. In the first part (Introduction, pp. 1-10), the candidate presented the structure of the thesis and outlined the roots of antisemitism and the Holocaust, especially as regards the situation of women. It presented all relevant and important data. Nevertheless, there is a factual mistake about the "return" to Palestine in p. 7. The second part (pp. 11-15) outlined the plots of five novels by five different authors. This main body of the thesis compares the treatment of female characters in the novels (pp. 16-28) and confronts the fictitious lives of the characters with the reality of the Holocaust (pp. 29-37), which is probably the candidate's best contribution to the study. The candidate's method is to characterize the different characters by rather descriptive comparisons. Nevertheless, it reveals the principal features. The final parts (pp. 38-43) are the Conclusion summarizing the findings and extensive relevant Bibliography. The primary and secondary sources are well selected and appropriately used. The standard of language and style is good throughout (except a few minor grammar mistakes and misprints, e.g. pp. 5, 8). The formal aspects of the thesis, references and bibliography comply with the requirements. The thesis shows the candidate's appropriate knowledge of the subject	



matter. In conclusion, the candidate has manifested her ability to produce a study fulfilling all the necessary standards and requirements for a Bc. thesis in the field.
