Odůvodnění hodnocení a celkové shrnutí:

The work approaches an extremely interesting topic which is the methodology of measurement of microfinance institutions from the point of view of audit, due diligence and rating. It is a highly original and well structured achievement, which provides a new angle of evaluation of the sector and thus manages to contribute to the general knowledge. The value of this work lies in the capacity of summarization and provision of an overview of a sub-sectorial theme, which does not find itself in the limelight of scholars, yet it is the more important as it is due the audit, due diligence and rating that MFIs are funded and appreciated by global public. The work however provides a shallow answer to the questions raised. Although the topics are well described, the answers are not easily generalizable and evidence that would justify such conclusion, is rather superficial. SWOT analysis cannot be an ultimative tool to reach conclusions, despite its good application. For this reason, the work cannot be marked as perfect, although it is on the best course to become so if another layer of profundity and analysis were added. For this reason the evaluation reached is very good.
