## Feedback on your Individual Thesis Project

As thesis supervisor, I write to provide the following feedback on your thesis written report;

## Introduction, Methods and Results

An excellent introduction, demonstrating extensive research of the agronomy of citrus crops. The choice of the study area should have been part of the aim and the detail explained in the methods. Clear, logical method for the model development, building on the understanding of citrus agronomy in the introduction. It would have been good to see a fuller justification for the use of RCP8.5 and the assumption of full irrigation.

## **Discussion and Conclusions**

The discussion is comprehensive but not easy to follow. It refers a lot to heat-stress, but it is not clear if this is only referencing to the fruit-set factor or other stresses. The results of the rain damage factor do not seem to be presented or discussed.

## Style and Presentation

Generally excellent presentation, with a few minor typos and grammatical errors. The discussion of literature in 4.2 as a stand-alone section, appears out of place. It should have be integrated with the author's own results, otherwise it appears to be a literature review which should have come at the start.
