Homepage

Use Case 1: Homepage Navigation

Primary Actor

• Website User

Preconditions

• The user has accessed the GlobeTrotter homepage.

Postconditions

• The user navigates to one of the services or sections available from the homepage.

Main Success Scenario

- 1. **User Action**: User lands on the GlobeTrotter homepage.
- 2. **System Action**: Displays the homepage with the image carousel, navigation bar, search panel, user testimonials, travel tips and news, and newsletter subscription call to action.
- 3. **User Action**: Selects an option from the navigation bar (e.g., Flights, Hotels, Car Rentals, Special Offers, Customer Support).
- 4. **System Action**: Redirects the user to the selected page or section.

Use Case 2: Interacting with the Image Carousel

Primary Actor

• Website User

Preconditions

• The user is viewing the homepage.

Postconditions

• The user has interacted with the image carousel to view various popular destinations.

Main Success Scenario

- 1. **User Action**: Watches the auto-rotating image carousel or manually navigates through the images.
- 2. **System Action**: Displays images of popular destinations, potentially with brief descriptions or promotions.
- 3. **User Action**: Clicks on an image if interested in learning more about a destination or related offers.
- 4. **System Action**: Takes the user to a detailed page about the destination or the offer.

Use Case 3: Starting a Booking from the Homepage

Primary Actor

• Website User

Preconditions

• The user is on the homepage.

Postconditions

• The user has initiated a booking process for flights, hotels, or car rentals.

Main Success Scenario

1. **User Action**: Enters basic booking criteria into the search panel (e.g., dates, destination).

- 2. **System Action**: Displays a dynamic form appropriate for the selected service (flights, hotels, car rentals).
- 3. **User Action**: Completes the form with specific details and submits the search.
- 4. **System Action**: Redirects the user to the search results page for the selected service with relevant options.

Use Case 4: Subscribing to the Newsletter

Primary Actor

Preconditions

• The user is interested in receiving travel tips, news, and special offers.

Postconditions

• The user subscribes to the GlobeTrotter newsletter.

Main Success Scenario

Use Case 6: Reviewing User Testimonials

- 1. **User Action**: Scrolls to the user testimonials section.

- 3. **User Action**: Reads through the testimonials.

4. **System Action**: Optionally, allows the user to navigate through more testimonials if available.

Flight Search Engine:

Use Case 1: Initiate Flight Search

Primary Actor

• Website User

Stakeholders and Interests

- Website User: Wants to easily initiate a search for flights.
- Website Owner: Seeks to provide an intuitive search initiation process.

Preconditions

• The user is on the GlobeTrotter homepage or the Flights page.

Postconditions

• The user has successfully entered search parameters and initiated a flight search.

Main Success Scenario

- 1. **User Action**: Navigates to the "Flights" section.
- 2. **System Action**: Displays the dynamic search form.
- 3. **User Action**: Inputs departure and arrival locations, dates, passenger numbers, and class of service.
- 4. **System Action**: Displays the "Search" button.

Use Case 2: Destination Autofill Suggestions

Primary Actor

• Website User

Preconditions

• The user is inputting a departure or arrival location in the search form.

Postconditions

• The user selects a location from the autofill suggestions.

Main Success Scenario

- 1. **User Action**: Begins typing a location name.
- 2. **System Action**: Dynamically displays matching suggestions in real-time.
- 3. **User Action**: Selects the correct location from the suggestions.

Use Case 3: Use Flexible Dates Feature
