**Other comments or suggestions:**

It is important to stress that the student had to change the subject of her research on the spot when realising that the intended poultry farm which she aimed to investigate as a case study of the opportunity for local business development no longer operate (in contrast of the previous assurance that the farm did well).

In spite of that the student collected interesting data. However, the fact that the data survey was not designed in the light of future analysis limited the student in stating the hypotheses and her research.

The student tried to introduce some concept but found difficult to operationalise them in the combination of empirical analysis and theoretical considerations.
