Partial comments and suggestions:

Minor typographical or grammatical errors might be identified in text (e.g. indent of headings in the Content, page numbering associated with the second page of the Content, redundant blank spaces - p.12 etc.).

There is a clear and meaningful research question, which answering is based on two subquestions. However, the first one might have been divided into two separate questions dealing with design and implementation.

The research strategy (methodology) is explicitly stated. The sample size in the quantitative research might have been bigger. However, author understands limitations connected with such small sample size.

There is one redundant page with bibliography inserted at the end of the printed version of the thesis.

Survey questionnaire should have been presented in the thesis at least as an Appendix.

Although author considers several perspectives, the thesis seems to be little bit over-structured.

Questions:

How likely will your thesis influence the current situation in Kosovo? Do you, personally, have any mechanisms how to enforce required changes?

Overall assessment and classification reasoning:

The master thesis has sufficient extent and its value added is quite significant, since author's own work represents approx. two thirds of the thesis length. Author uses adequate number of information resources, which are cited within the text. Author is familiar with all concepts related to research (secondary data, sample size etc.). Formulated aims were achieved.
