The bachelor's thesis has clearly defined goals and methodology. The work has a clear structure and is well organized in terms of content. In the theoretical part, the author demonstrated knowledge and orientation in the chosen issue. I have no formal or stylistic comments on the presented work (except for minor details), the author has demonstrated the ability to work independently with professional literature, references to sources are in accordance with the valid citation standard. I find some shortcomings in the theoretical part, where the author could have dealt more deeply with the issue of mobile applications in crisis management. In the author's own work, I find a deficiency in the more detailed clarification of the combination of a questionnaire survey with qualitative research. The author demonstrated the ability to apply the chosen methods and the goals of the work were fulfilled. I recommend the work for defense.
