introducing the methodology, where the author presents procedures selected for achieving the

above mentioned objectives. Working methods are selected accordingly and provide a sufficient

methodological and analytical apparatus for achieving previously defined objectives.

For this reason, I recommend the dissertation for defense before the committee for the defense of

dissertations and after a successful defense of the title Ph.D.
