Other comments or suggestions:

Beksultan presents interesting overview of hotel and tourism development in Kazakhstan. He worked continuously and consulted regularly. However, some of supervisors comments were not observed (better interpretation of the data, improved referencing, etc.).

On the other hand, I need to highlight Beksultans ability to dig for data which were not easy to get (i.e. data from Booking.com – own collection or data from UNWTO, which were not opened and had to be acquired by author.)

Even if the theses comes with valuable conclusions, there are problems to be mentioned:

- a) Graphs, tables and numbers does not follow required format
- b) Graphical quality of some tables is questionable
- c) Some information could be analysed more in detail (references from Booking.com)
- d) Impact of EXPO on Kazakh tourism could be analysed by Author himself (using available data), not to quote results of official governmental reports. Data for that were available.

In general, I can conclude, that the theses has its quality, presents certain value added, author collected, processed and analysed a lot of data. However, the theses has some imperfections. I propose to be evaluated as =GOOD=.
