theory based. There is no Sufficient information about the previous study findings is presented for readers to follow the present study rationale and procedures.

It was preferable when carrying out the practical study that some statistical models be used in the study of Impact of Adopting Renewable Energy Technologies on The Economic Growth and Ecology in the Russian Federation.

Also, the correct variables were not used in the study, as it was expected that other variables would be used. The method of dividing the practical section and explaining the differences is not completely clear, as the study objectives were not achieved in general.

## Questions for thesis defence:

- 1- Why was the descriptive analytical approach not used in this research, it would have interduces better results and the use of more statistical data to delve deeper into the research.
- 2- Why was Russia chosen in general to carry out the study on it, considering that as it was discussed during the research that there are some weaknesses in Russia in this field, it was better to use another sample in which the impact can be clearly explained.

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
