## Other comments or suggestions:

The bachelor thesis is focused on the determinants of on-line shopping and contains both, the theoretical and the practical part.

However, several weaknesses can found as following.

- The formulation of the Objectives is hardly understandable. It should be
- The citations in the Methodology (chapters 2.3 and 2.4 are totally missing).
- The theoretical part is not fully in accordance with the citation norm.
- The structure of the rpactical part and its the content is not explained well.
- The computation error can be observed in the practical part (the index analysis). Moreover, the comments should be deeper and more precise.

The regression analysis is not done properly. Possible improvement can be seen in this part.

- There is no clear linkage between the data sets and methods used.
- More attention could be paind also to the formal requirements (the consistency of the text) and English language.

Besides the weaknesses mentioned above, the main problem can be seen in the relationship between the topic of the bachelor thesis and its content. Even the examination and explanation of the impact of Covid-19 pandemic on consumption was stated as the topic and the main aim, it is not focused in the thesis at all (except the introduction and the conclusion, however, not directly in own analysis).

In conclusion, the thesis cannot be recommended to defense since it does not fulfill the minimal requirement for the bachelor thesis.
