The work depicts the situation related to international funding in an extremely interesting microfinance market in Nigeria. It asks robust questions that could have an important impact for the understanding of the nature of the market. Another positive part of the work is that it transcends sector of common non-profit MFIs and also touches the commercial microfinance sector. Formatting is in several ways weak /e.g. formulas/, recommendation is too general and not well connected to findings of the research. The work can be considered as shallow in certain points, however still valid as a masters thesis and covering an interesting topic, extremely difficult for data collection.
